Adding register totals into Insight Solutions Web Based Data Quality Tool

When filling in the Web Based DQA disease register totals, most disease register totals will be obvious, as they will be the total number of patients on each register (e.g. CHD, Diabetes etc). The totals that will not be so obvious will be:

Depression***


This is the total number of patients with Depression EVER, who are still depressed, this list can be found within the various clinical systems as follows:

EMIS LV and EMIS PCS – Look in Population Manager in clinical indicators and then in Depression and then click on ‘Depression denominator populations’ and look for ‘Patients with Depression’.

Vision – Look in Clinical Audit under the heading of QOF monitoring reports and under the heading of Depression and look for ‘Patients with Depression ever’.

iSoft – In Contract+ under Contract Status go to the ‘Today’ tab and under the heading of Depression and ‘DEP4’ look for ‘DEP register size’.

TPP – In S1 you can't see the number of patients who have ever had depression. Create search from Reporting – Clinical Reporting – New and select Read Coded Entries from the Clinical Folder and enter the following



Click OK and then run the selected report to find the total number of patients for your depression register

Depression 1

This is the total number of patients with either CHD or Diabetes or both who are eligible for the ‘Depression screening questions’, and can be found as follows:

EMIS LV and EMIS PCS – Look in Population Manager in clinical indicators and then in Depression and then click on ‘Depression denominator populations’ and look for ‘Patients with CHD or Diabetes’.

Vision – Look in Clinical Audit under the heading of QOF monitoring reports and under the heading of Depression and look for ‘Patients with CHD or Diabetes’.

Isoft – In Contract+ under Contract Status go to the 'Today' tab and under the heading of Depression and 'DEP1' look for 'DEP1 register size'.

TPP – Look in QOF Indicators and under the Depression section look for the indicator DEP1. You need to record the total number of patients eligible for this indicator not amount achieved. (Eg. If showed 187/202 (187 being the number who have achieved and 202 being the number eligible))

Depression Incidence

This is the total number of newly diagnosed Depression patients who are eligible for a Depression assessment (ie PHQ-9 or HAD score) and can be found as follows:

EMIS LV and EMIS PCS – Look in Population Manager in clinical indicators and then in Depression and then click on 'Depression denominator populations' and look for '[DEP4] eligible for depression assessment'.

Vision – Look in Clinical Audit under the heading of QOF monitoring reports and under the heading of Depression and look for 'Dep4 eligible for depression assessment'.

Isoft – In Contract+ under Contract Status go to the 'Today' tab and under the heading of Depression and 'DEP4' look at the Patient's column to identify the number achieved against the number who qualify. (Eg. If showed 187/202 (187 being the number who have achieved and 202 being the number eligible)).

TPP – Look in QOF Indicators and under the Depression section look for the indicator DEP4. You need to record the total number of patients eligible for this indicator not amount achieved. (Eg. If showed 187/202 (187 being the number who have achieved and 202 being the number eligible))

CVD (Primary Prevention)

This is the total number of patients who are newly diagnosed with Hypertension who are eligible for (Primary prevention i.e. CVD risk score or Lifestyle advice), and can be found as follows:

EMIS LV and EMIS PCS – Look in Population Manager in clinical indicators and then in PP and then click on 'PP denominator populations' and look for 'PPO patients eligible for monitoring'.

Vision – Look in Clinical Audit under the heading of QOF monitoring reports and under the heading of PP – Primary Prevention and look for 'Patients eligible for PP monitoring'.

Isoft – In Contract+ under Contract Status go to the 'Today' tab and under the heading of CVD Primary Prevention look at the PP2 Indicator and record the total number of patients eligible for this indicator not the amount achieved. (Eg. If showed 187/202 (187 being the number who have achieved and 202 being the number eligible))

TPP – Look in QOF Indicators and under the Cardiovascular Disease Primary prevention section look for the indicator PP – CVD Register. You need to record the total number of patients on this register
